### BAVARIA GATE

Built in 1425, the Bavaria Gate is one of the most beautiful and best preserved Gothic city gates in Germany. As you climb the gate, you will go on a journey through time and space discovering the history of the Bavaria Gate in film and text. Enjoy the view of the Alps and the old town from the viewing platform.

### HISTORIC TOWN HALL

The historic town hall is one of the most impressive buildings of the city, and not just from the outside. Visitors can admire an art exhibition of paintings by the Landsberg painter Johann Mutter, stucco work by Dominikus Zimmermann, a magnificent interior, the hall of Herkomer and a splendid historic banqueting hall.

### HERKOMER MUSEUM & ADMISSION TO THE “MUTTERTURM”

Already a legend in his lifetime, Hubert von Herkomer became famous for his work as a portrait painter of personalities such as Richard Wagner and Kaiser Wilhelm. The museum is dedicated to the work and pioneering spirit of this exceptionally talented artist, being among other things a famous sculptor, composer and pioneer of motor sport events.

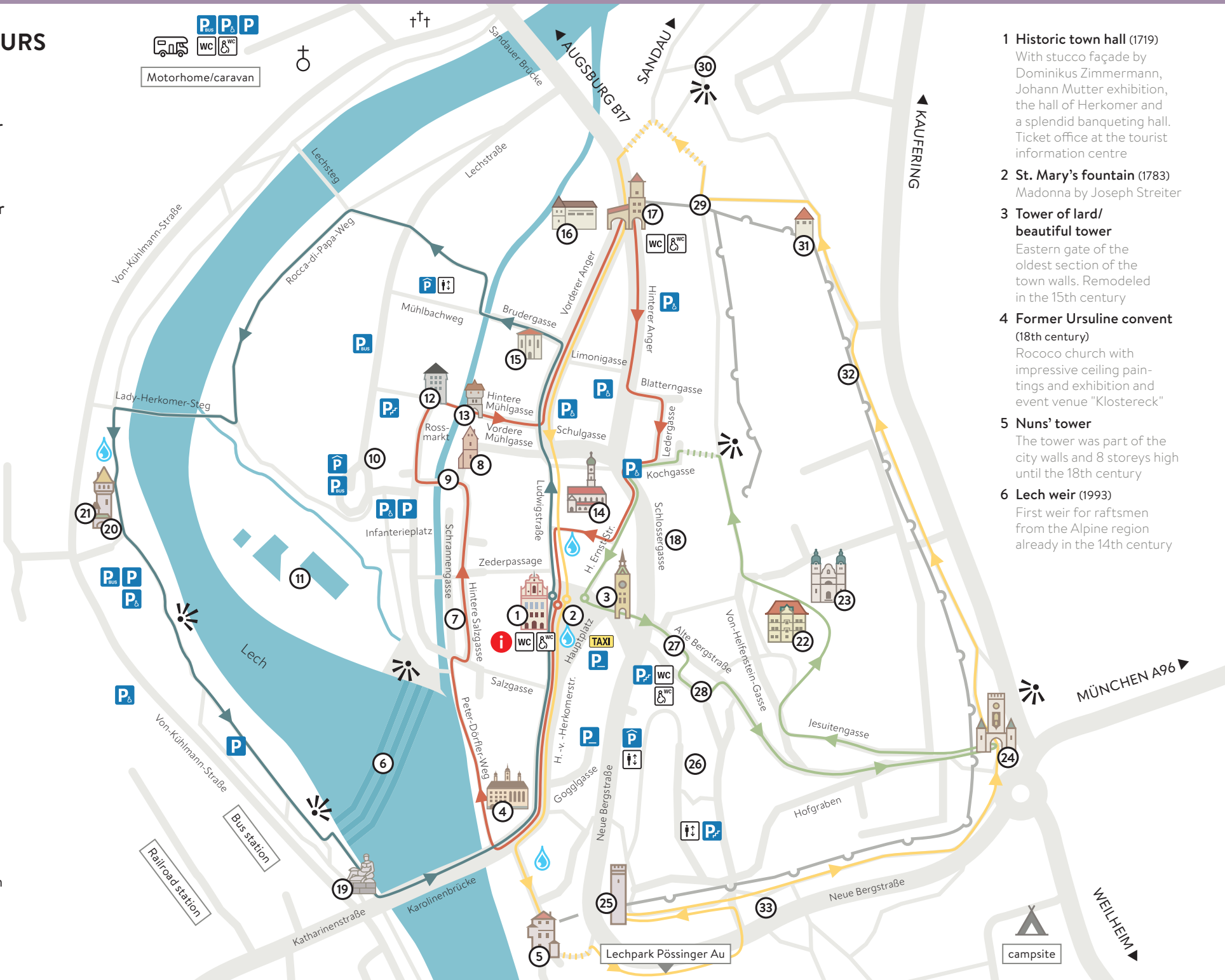

## 1 Historic town hall (1719)

With stucco façade by Dominikus Zimmermann, Johann Mutter exhibition, the hall of Herkomer and a splendid banqueting hall. Ticket office at the tourist information centre

## 2 St. Mary's fountain (1783)

Madonna by Joseph Streiter

## 3 Tower of lard/beautiful tower

Eastern gate of the oldest section of the town walls. Remodeled in the 15th century

## 4 Former Ursuline convent (18th century)

Rococo church with impressive ceiling paintings and exhibition and event venue "Klostereck"

## 5 Nuns' tower

The tower was part of the city walls and 8 storeys high until the 18th century

## 6 Lech weir (1993)

First weir for raftsmen from the Alpine region already in the 14th century

**7 Salt barn (1754)**  
The salt trade was of great economic importance for Landsberg

**8 Witches' tower (1270)**  
Corner tower of the oldest town wall ring

## 9 Former town mills

**10 "Lechstadel" (1630)**  
Today the town library. Formerly one of the three salt warehouses

## 11 "Inselbad"

Outdoor pool in a unique location with direct access to the river Lech

## 12 Dyers' gate (1520)

**13 Bakers' gate (1435)**  
Town gate with different gables

## 14 Town church (15th century)

Built by Matthäus von Ensin-gen. Impressive Baroque church with Late Gothic stained glass windows. Works of art: High altar, wooden sculptures by Lorenz and Johann Luidl (17th century), Madonna by Hans Multscher (1440)

## 15 St John's church (1754)

Picturesque rococo church by Dominikus Zimmermann

**16 Dyers' court (16th century)**  
Former municipal dye house with arcaded courtyard

## 17 Sandau gate (1630)

Northern city gate. Rebuilt during the Thirty Year's War

## 18 Town theatre (19th century)

Historic town theatre

## 19 Father Lech (1952)

Stone sculpture

## 20 Mother tower (1884)

Former studio of Hubert von Herkomer. Access via the Herkomer Museum

## 21 Herkomer museum

Museum about the life & work of Hubert von Herkomer (Monday closed)

**22 Town museum**  
Exhibition about the city history of Landsberg

## 23 Church of the holy Cross (1752)

Church of the former Jesuit monastery

## 24 Bavaria gate (1425)

Late gothic town gate, incl. exhibition and best view over the town. Ticket office on the first floor (closed on Mondays)

## 25 Maiden's leap tower (14th century)

The name refers to a legend about atrocities during the Thirty Year's War

## 26 Fountain chapel (1756)

**27 Street "Alte Bergstraße"**  
Road for the former salt merchants from the Bavaria Gate to the city centre

**28 Witches' quarter**  
Back of old tanners' and dyers' houses

## 29 "Dachl"/"Lueginisland" tower (16th century)

Highest of all defence towers. Named after the jackdaws once nesting here

## 30 "Hohes Kreuz" (16th century)

Crucifixion group

## 31 Powder tower (16th century)

Former gunpowder store and cannon tower

## 32 Town walls

Very well preserved town walls with remains of compound and moat

## 33 Death march memorial

Death march memorial for the inmates of the eleven subcamps of the Dachau concentration camp along the "Neue Bergstraße"
